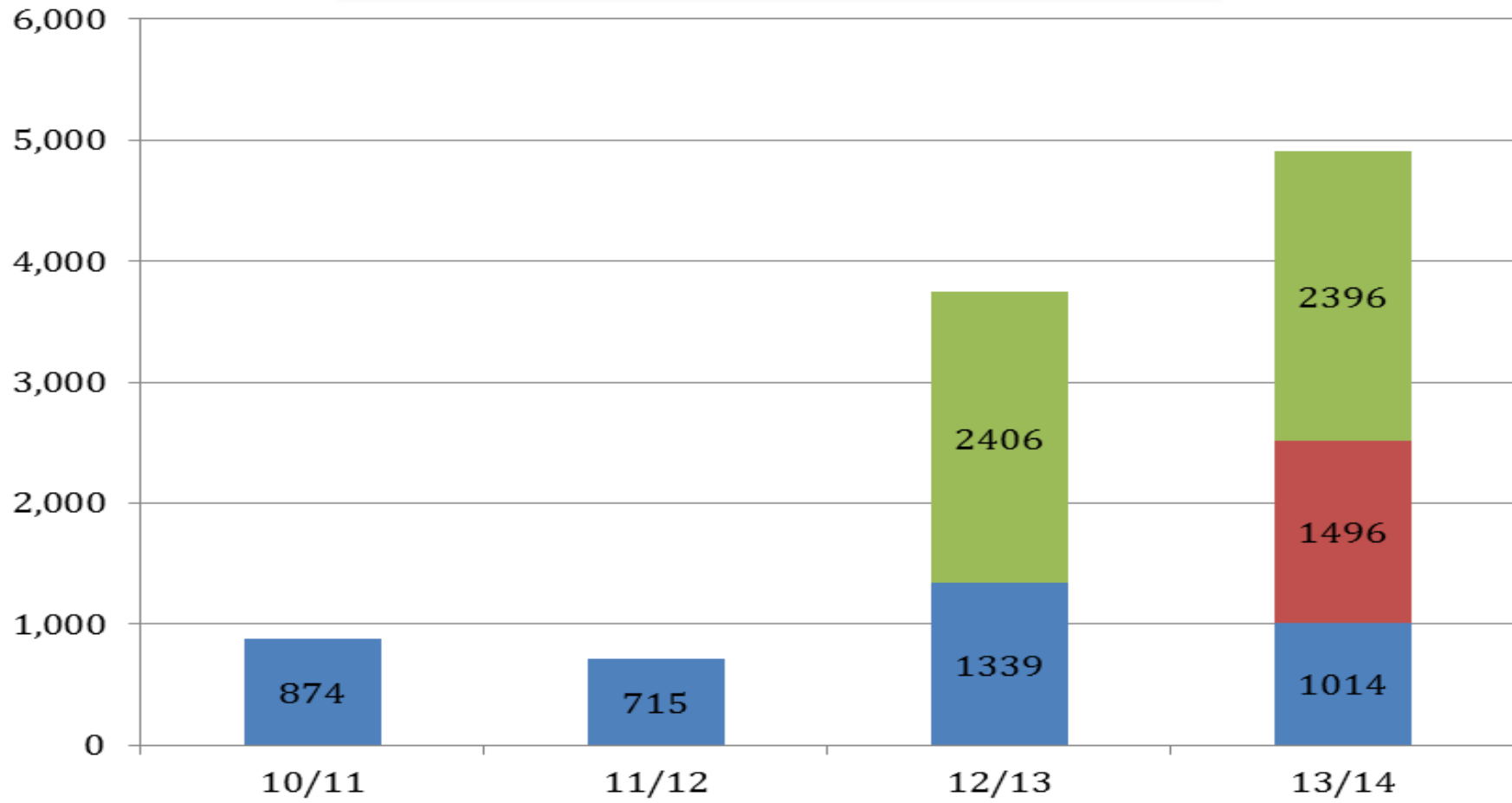

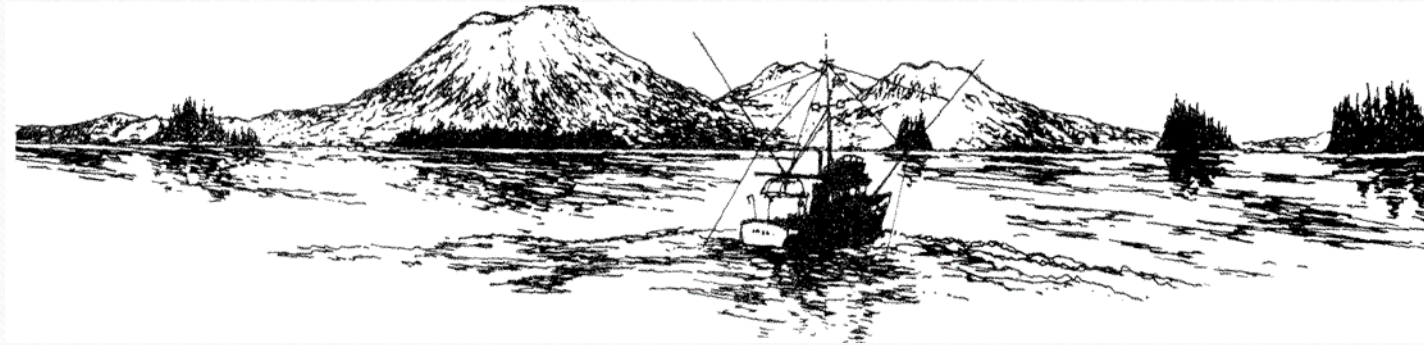
- PHS is our alternative high school
