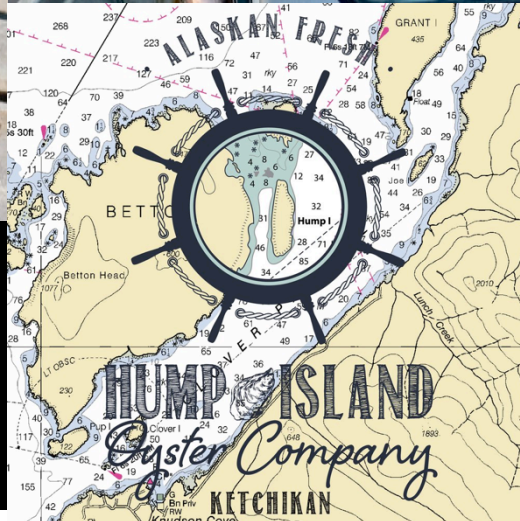

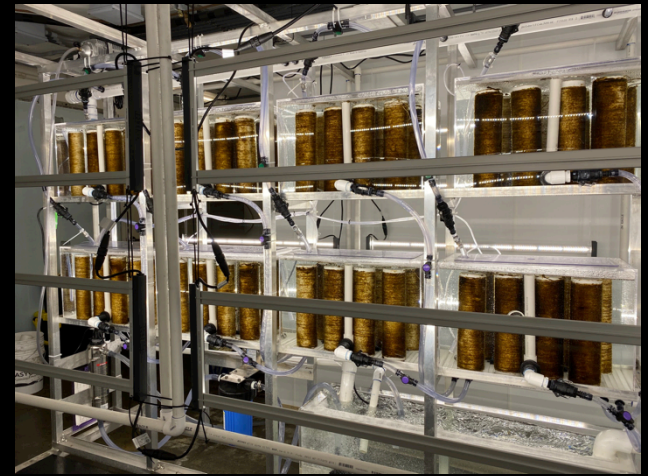

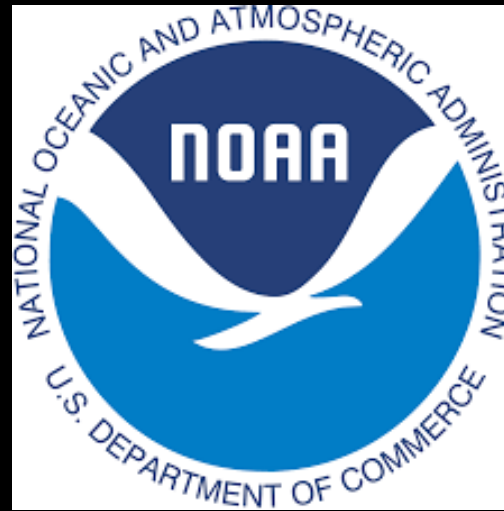
Proposed DEC Budget cuts to PSP testing

- \$228,850 proposed cut in 2020
- \$457,700 proposed cut in 2023

*Operating costs in Alaska will spike to 6108% higher than WA

-\$24,005 /farm to sell shellfish year round

HB 116-Lease Renewals

- Allows the ADNR commissioner to sign off on the renewal of leases in good standing. Without this bill farms have to start the leasing process all over again after 10 years.

HB 41-Shellfish Enhancement

- Allows enhancement and rehabilitation of shellfish.

- ADFG is streamlining their permitting process
