- Tripled growth in sales from 2018 to 2019.

- Most technologically state of the art event hall in Juneau.

# COURIER SERVICE

- Employs 3 Tribal Citizens
- Created to meet the demand of Tlingit and Haida's spread out campuses across Juneau.
- In 2020 we are looking to expand our courier services.



# LITTLE EAGLE AND RAVENS NEST

## LEARN Child Care

- Employs 15 staff
- Created to meet the demand (Crisis) of childcare shortage in Juneau.
- 60 spaces for children from infants to age six.
- This center boasts state-of-the-art software (Brightwheel) that provides real-time communication with parents on child's daily behaviors & activities.
- LEARN will have a custom curriculum that is culturally responsive and place-based.
